BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, April 7, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p><i>A Severe Weather Watch</i> is now in effect for the islands of the Northern Bahamas (Grand Bahama, Abaco and Bimini) as well as portions of the Northwest Bahamas (Berry Islands, Northern Andros, New Providence, Northern Eleuthera) along with their adjacent waters and cays. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</p> <p><i>A Gale Warning (34 – 40 knots)</i> is in effect for the Northern Bahamas. Occasional gusts to gale force are possible across the Northern Bahamas <i>beginning 12pm Wednesday afternoon to 6am Thursday morning.</i> Boaters, especially small craft, are urged to seek safe harbour and remain in port in the areas of the Gulf Stream and Atlantic waters. GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A frontal boundary across the Northern Bahamas, along with an associated low-pressure system, will continue to support shower and thunderstorm activity across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas tonight. The low is forecast to shift east into the Atlantic on Wednesday, however, the frontal boundary will linger across the Northwest Bahamas through Wednesday, maintaining cloudy conditions and unsettled weather conditions across the area.</p> <p><i>Outlook:</i> Behind the front, strong to gale force breezes will create dangerous beaching and boating conditions, while the boundary stalls and weakens across the Northwest Bahamas by Friday. High pressure will strengthen behind the front, allowing the winds to increase across the island chain through the end of the week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p><i>Flooding:</i> There is a marginal to moderate risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas across the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas due to heavy and prolonged rainfall events. <i>Residents are urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas, especially in areas already inundated with water from previous rainfall events.</i></p> <p><i>Rip Currents:</i> There is a slight to moderate risk of rip currents for all Atlantic coastal waters of the island chain. <i>Swimmers are advised to exercise caution when entering these waters</i></p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Cloudy to overcast through tomorrow		
PRECIPITATION:	50 to 70% chance of showers with thunderstorms. <i>Showers may become heavy and thunderstorms severe at times.</i>		
WINDS:	Southwest to west at 10 knots or less ahead of the trough, and north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots behind the trough tonight, becoming north to northeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts tomorrow morning and increasing to 20 to 25 knots with <i>gusts up to gale force</i> by the afternoon hours. <i>Expect gusty conditions in the vicinity of heavy showers and thunderstorms.</i>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy with occasional cloudy periods through tomorrow.		
PRECIPITATION:	30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms. <i>Showers may become heavy and thunderstorms severe at times.</i>		
WINDS:	Southwest to west at 10 knots or less this evening becoming light and variable overnight. North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots by Wednesday evening. Expect gusty conditions in the vicinity of heavy showers and thunderstorms.

PRECIPITATION:	20 to 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms through tomorrow.		
WINDS:	Variable at less than 10 knots.

PRECIPITATION:	10 to 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorm through tomorrow.		
WINDS:	Variable at less than 10 knots.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 9 TH APRIL, 2026.			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy at first, with gradual clearing throughout the day. Expect mostly fair conditions at night. Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, becoming partly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of showers during the morning hours, decreasing 10 to 30% by the afternoon hours. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: North-northeast to east-northeast at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts. Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less, veering west to northwest at 10 knots or less as the front approaches. Expect winds to increase to 15 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly to occasionally cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots with <i>possible gusts to near gale.</i> Central Bahamas: Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, shifting northeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts behind the front. Expect winds to become light and variable at times in the vicinity of the front.
