BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Wednesday, February 4, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p>A near GALE WARNING (34-30 knots) will come into effect for the Northern Bahamas by Thursday afternoon and for the remainder of the Northwest Bahamas by evening hours. For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website @ met.gov.bs.</p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>High pressure will continue to dominate the weather pattern across the islands tonight while gradually shifting further east into the western Atlantic through Thursday.</p> <p>Outlook: Another round of fresh to strong near gale force breezes, rough seas and colder temperatures will accompany another cold front as it enters the Northern Bahamas on Thursday. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will be along and ahead of the front and winds will begin to increase to near gale force by the afternoon hours across the Northern and Northwestern islands as the front advances. By Thursday night, widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms can be expected across the Central and Southeastern islands due to the front combined with troughing, along with streaming moisture from the Caribbean Sea. Winds will quickly diminish to fresh to moderate breezes on Friday and the cooler air mass along with stable weather conditions behind the front will linger across the island chain through the weekend.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents: There is a high risk of dangerous, life threatening rip currents and rough surf along all windward and Atlantic shorelines. The public is urged to remain out of the water until further notice.</p> <p>Coastal Threats: Overtopping waves, sea spray and coastal debris may continue to impact northern and western roadways. Motorists and pedestrians should exercise extreme caution while traversing these areas, especially during high tide cycle.</p>

WINDS:	Southwest to West at 10 to 15 knots through early tomorrow, shifting West to Northwest and increasing 15 to 20 knots by afternoon hours, then 20 to 30 knots with higher gust to near gale force by late evening.

PRECIPITATION:	20-30% chance of showers with a possible thunderstorm or two with the approach of the front.		
WINDS:	Southwest to West at 10 to 15 knots through early tomorrow, shifting West to Northwest and increasing 15 to 20 knots by afternoon hours, then 20 to 30 knots with higher gust to near gale force by late evening.
