



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Wednesday, April 8, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<p><b><i>A Severe Weather Watch</i></b> remains in effect for the islands of the Northern Bahamas (Grand Bahama, Abaco and Bimini) as well as portions of the Northwest Bahamas (Berry Islands, Northern Andros, New Providence, and Northern Eleuthera) along with their adjacent waters and cays. The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</p> <p>There are no public warnings in effect at this time. <b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>Unsettled weather will persist across the northern half of the country tonight through Thursday as troughing associated with a weakening frontal boundary lingers over the area. In contrast, more stable conditions will prevail elsewhere under the influence of weak high pressure and a relatively dry air mass. Strong to near gale-force winds are expected over the Northern Bahamas, while generally gentle to moderate breezes will continue across the remainder of the island chain.</p> <p><b><i>Outlook:</i></b> The aforementioned front is expected to gradually weaken as it drifts southward, reaching the Central Bahamas by Friday and the Southeast Bahamas by Saturday. This will increase the likelihood of showers and thunderstorms across those areas through the end of the work week. In the wake of the front, high pressure will build, leading to fresh to strong winds across the island chain into the weekend. Meanwhile, a dry and stable air mass will settle in behind the boundary, bringing generally fair conditions and milder temperatures to the northern half of the country.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b><i>Flash Flooding:</i></b> There is a marginal to moderate risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas across the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas due to heavy and prolonged rainfall events. Residents are urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas, especially in areas already inundated with water from previous rainfall events.</p> <p><b><i>Rip Currents:</i></b> There is a <b>high</b> risk of rip currents for all Atlantic coastal waters and Passages of the island chain. Swimmers are advised to refrain from entering these waters and to exercise extreme caution when crossing the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera until further notice.</p>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mostly cloudy to overcast tonight through tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	50 to 70% chance of scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms tonight through tomorrow.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeast to east at 20 – 25 knots with gusts to near gale force tonight through tomorrow.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Variably cloudy tonight becoming mostly cloudy tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	40 to 60% chance of widely scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms tonight through tomorrow.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeast to east at 15 knots tonight with slightly higher gusts tomorrow.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mainly fair tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	30% chance of a few isolated showers late tonight into the overnight hours, decreasing to a 20% chance of a few isolated showers or thunderstorms tomorrow.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeast to east at 10 knots or less tonight, veering east to southeast overnight and falling light and variable at times through tomorrow.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mainly fair tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	10 - 20% chance of an isolated shower or two tonight through tomorrow.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Light and variable tonight, shifting east to southeast at 10 knots or less tomorrow.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>
	80°F – 83°F / 26°C – 28°C	75°F – 77°F / 22°C – 25°C	N/A

<b>EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026</b>			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	<i>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</i> Mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming mainly fair at night. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> Partly to occasionally cloudy.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<i>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</i> 10 – 20% chance of showers. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale. <i>Central Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> East to southeast at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, shifting northeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts behind the front. Expect winds to become light and variable at times in the vicinity of the front.

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<i>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</i> 10 – 20% chance of showers. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> 20 – 40% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, increasing 20 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 15 knots, increasing 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts.
