BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Wednesday, September 2, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

Deep layered troughing across the Northern Bahamas along with an abundance of tropical moisture is maintaining the moist unstable airmass across the Northern, Northwest and portions of the Central Bahamas through tomorrow. A few remnant showers and isolated thunderstorms is moving northwestward across the Southeast Bahamas tonight, decreasing through tomorrow.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: By late Friday, activity is expected to ease slightly, particularly across the Central and Southeast Bahamas. However, lingering moisture across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas will continue to support occasional afternoon showers and thunderstorms. On Sunday, troughing associated with a frontal boundary near the southeastern United States is expected to bring another increase in shower and thunderstorm activity across the Northern Bahamas. Meanwhile, an approaching tropical wave is expected to enter the Southeast Bahamas, resulting in an uptick in shower and thunderstorm chances across that region.

Severe Weather Risk: There is a **moderate to high** risk of isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas, mainly along the eastern flanks of the region. The public should monitor for the issuance of any watches or warnings from The Bahamas Department of Meteorology, and boaters should prepare to seek safe harbour once conditions worsen.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flood Risk: There is a **slight to moderate** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas.**

Rip Currents: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of rip currents along the **eastern and southern shorelines of the Bahamas. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution along eastern and southern shorelines.**
