BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Wednesday, July 1, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

GENERAL SITUATION:

A dissipating frontal boundary across the Northern Bahamas continues to generate showers and thunderstorms over the area. Meanwhile, a weak surface trough over the Southeast Bahamas will support a few isolated showers and thunderstorms tonight. By tomorrow, a thin layer of Saharan dust is expected to spread across the islands, leading to drier conditions. Elsewhere, high pressure remains the dominant weather feature across the country, supporting hot and humid conditions, light to moderate winds, smooth seas, and only a few passing showers or an isolated thunderstorm.

Outlook: Persistent troughing across the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas will continue to support an increased chance of showers and thunderstorms through Friday, while a plume of Saharan dust suppresses shower and thunderstorm activity across the Central and Southeast Bahamas. By late Friday, a tropical wave accompanied by an upper-level disturbance will approach from the east, increasing moisture and instability across the region. As a result, shower and thunderstorm activity is expected to become more widespread over the weekend, even as high pressure strengthens across the archipelago.

Rip Currents: A slight to moderate risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines tonight and through the next six days. Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat/UV Index: **Very high to extreme UV indices** expected daily (11am–4pm) through the forecast period. Heat indices will reach triple digits across all areas tomorrow, moderating slightly by the weekend. Public is advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas.

Saharan Dust: A plume of Saharan dust will bring hazy conditions and reduced visibility to the Central and Southeast Bahamas through Friday. People with respiratory ailments should take precautions.
