BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Wednesday, January 22, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	A gale warning is in effect for the Northern Bahamas. <i>For more information please see the marine forecast.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A cold front is slowly drifting across the Northwest Bahamas tonight producing light to moderate showers along with cloudy conditions mainly along the boundary. Expect strong gusty winds to gale force across the Northern Bahamas behind the front. Rough seas with moderate to large sea swells are within the Northern and Northwest Bahamas and along all Atlantic exposed coastlines. The front will continue Southeastward moving into the Central Bahamas tomorrow before stalling.</p> <p>Outlook: An area of low pressure will deepen along a frontal boundary in the Northern Bahamas late Thursday maintaining shower activity throughout the Northern and Northwestern Islands along with fresh to strong winds, gusting to gale force along with rough seas into Saturday. The front will continue drifting southeastward through the weekend.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	A high risk of coastal flooding and rip currents is in place for all coastal waters in the Northern and Southern islands therefore residents are advised to exercise caution on coastal roads and beachgoers are encouraged to remain onshore as dangerous rip currents can sweep away swimmers. A moderate risk of rip currents is in place for northeast and east coastal waters in the Northwest and Central Bahamas therefore, beachgoers are advised to remain onshore.
