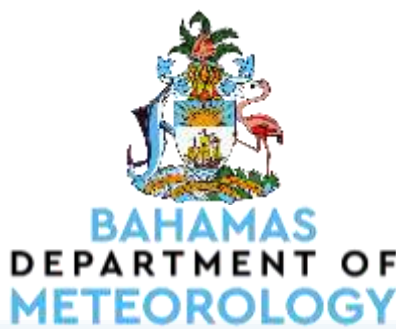

News Item on **Tropical Storm Edouard** issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology's Forecast Office section at **6:00 pm** Tuesday 01st, September 2026.

**...EDOUARD JUST INLAND ALONG THE NORTHWESTERN GULF COAST...
...GUSTY WINDS AND HEAVY RAINFALL CONTINUE SPREADING OVER
SOUTHEASTERN TEXAS...**

At 05:00 pm EDT, the center of **Tropical Storm Edouard** was located near **Latitude 29.9° North** and **Longitude 94.0° West** OR about 30 miles South of Cameron Louisiana OR about 5 miles West of Port Arthur Texas.

Edouard is moving toward the **Northwest at 7 miles per hour**. This motion is expected to continue FOR THE NEXT DAY OR SO. On the forecast track, the center of Edouard will continue moving inland over Eastern Texas through Wednesday.

Maximum **sustained winds are near 50 miles per hour, with higher gusts**. Additional strengthening is forecast before Edouard makes landfall today. Rapid weakening is expected after the center moves inland.
