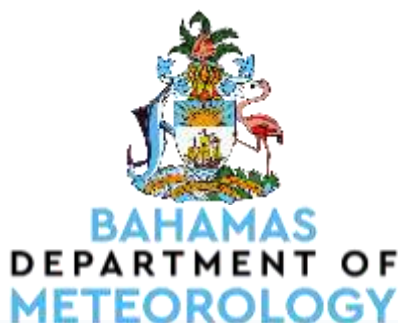

⚠ SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE ⚠

THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS UPDATED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2026 ON 9:08 AM EDT UNTIL 10:15 AM EDT.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR CAT ISLAND ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR BIMINI.

AT 9:05 AM EDT, OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY SHOWED DEVELOPING SMALL CLUSTERS OF HEAVY SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND SHOULD TAKE CARE TO AVOID THESE AREAS. RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
