



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT FRIDAY MAY 29, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

There is a **slight to moderate** risk of rip currents on east and southeastern coastlines of the island chain.

WARNINGS:

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Thunderstorms in the area can become strong, to severe, at times.

GENERAL SITUATION:

A weakened pressure pattern persists across the islands today into the weekend. Atmospheric moisture will increase across the island chain today into the weekend increasing the chance for showers and thunderstorms; additionally, a trough in the vicinity of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas will contribute to enhanced shower and thunderstorm activity across the area this weekend.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** No Advisory for seas. Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.
- WINDS:** South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet across all area waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells.
- WEATHER:** Isolated showers and thunderstorms.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** --No Advisory--
- WINDS:** Southeast at 10 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells.
- WEATHER:** Isolated showers and thunderstorms.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** --No Advisory--
- WINDS:** East to southeast at 10 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells.
- WEATHER:** Isolated showers.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** --No Advisory--
- WINDS:** East at 10 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 3 to 5 feet on the Atlantic waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells.
- WEATHER:** Isolated showers.
