



## BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT THURSDAY JUNE 25, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

**WARNINGS:**

There is a **slight to moderate risk** of rip currents for the Atlantic and east to southeastern coastlines of the Southeast Bahamas.

**Marine Heat Advisory:** Mariners are advised that **high heat indices** (above 105°F/40.5°C) are expected across the waters of The Bahamas. Prolonged exposure to the sun and hot conditions may increase the risk of heat-related illnesses. Stay hydrated, limit strenuous activity, seek shade when possible, and monitor crew members for signs of heat stress.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Thunderstorms in the area can become strong-to-severe at times.

**GENERAL SITUATION:**

Ridging will dominate the weather pattern through early next week, steering moderate to fresh breezes across the island through Saturday. Winds are expected to decrease slightly thereafter. A plume of Sahara dust will slowly spread across the islands from the southeast, resulting in a decrease in the chance for showers during the latter half of the weekend.

### NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** No advisory for seas. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet across all area waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Isolated afternoon showers and thunderstorms.

### NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** No advisory for seas. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet across all area waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Isolated afternoon showers and thunderstorms.

### CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the Atlantic waters. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** East-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with occasional higher gusts.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Isolated afternoon showers and thunderstorms.

### SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** There is a **small craft advisory** in effect for the Atlantic waters. There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the sheltered waters.
- WINDS:** East-southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 4 to 6 feet on the sheltered waters and 5 to 8 feet on the Atlantic waters.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Slight chance for an isolated shower.
