



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT TUESDAY MARCH 10, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNINGS: There is a moderate risk of rip currents for all east and southeast coastal waters in the Southeast Bahamas.

There is a slight risk of rip currents elsewhere across the island chain.

A ridge of high pressure will maintain generally warm and mostly stable conditions across the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas through Thursday; weakening middle-to upper-level troughing and residual moisture maintain isolated convection across the Southeast Bahamas.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Convection will increase into the weekend as a weakened cold front approaches and stalls in the vicinity of the Northern Bahamas on Friday.

Atlantic swells will gradually subside through Thursday.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the Atlantic waters.
WINDS: East at 10 knots with occasional higher gusts.
LOCAL SEAS: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells on the Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance for a few isolated showers.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the Atlantic waters.
WINDS: East at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts.
LOCAL SEAS: 2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells on the Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Slight chance for a few isolated showers.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: There is a **small craft advisory** in effect for the Atlantic waters.
WINDS: East at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
LOCAL SEAS: 2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 5 to 7 feet on the Atlantic waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells on the Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Chance for a few isolated showers.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: There is a **small craft advisory** in effect for the Atlantic and Inagua waters. There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the sheltered waters. Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: East at 15 to 20 knots with occasional strong gusts.
LOCAL SEAS: 4 to 6 feet on the sheltered waters and 5 to 7 feet on the Atlantic and Inagua waters.
SWELLS: Light easterly swells on the Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Isolated showers and thunderstorms.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY MARCH 11, 2026

*There is a **small craft advisory** in effect for the Atlantic waters of the Southeast Bahamas.*

ADVISORY: *There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the Atlantic waters of the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, as well as the sheltered waters of the Southeast Bahamas.*

WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 knots with occasional higher gusts.


Southeast Bahamas: East at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

SEAS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.

Southeast Bahamas: 4 to 6 feet on the sheltered waters and 5 to 7 feet on the Atlantic waters.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: No significant weather.

PRECIPITATION: Central and Southeast Bahamas: Isolated showers.



**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY MARCH 12, 2026**

*There is a **small craft caution** in effect for the Atlantic waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas.*

ADVISORY:

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.

WINDS:

Central Bahamas: East-southeast at 10 knots.

Southern Bahamas: East at 10 to 15 knots.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 3 to 5 feet on the Atlantic waters.

SEAS:

Central Bahamas: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.

Southern Bahamas: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.

Northern Bahamas: No significant weather; showers increase overnight...

PRECIPITATION:

Northwest and Bahamas: No significant weather.

Southern Bahamas: Isolated showers.
