



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 03, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

--Severe Weather Advisory--

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Thunderstorms in the area can become strong to severe at times; waterspout activity is possible.

WARNINGS:

--Sea Conditions--

There is a **moderate risk** of rip currents along the east and southeast coastal waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas and a **slight risk** of rip currents elsewhere on the waters of the archipelago.

GENERAL SITUATION:

A combination of surface troughing and a middle level low-pressure in the vicinity of the Northern Bahamas along with abundant tropical moisture will support convection across the islands into the weekend, mainly over the Northern and Northwest Bahamas and parts of the Central Bahamas; elsewhere, weak ridging will maintain mostly stable and warm conditions with chances of convection concentrated mainly during peak heating hours.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: No advisory for seas. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms...*

WINDS: Southeast at 10, with occasional higher gusts through the forecast period.

LOCAL SEAS: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters tonight; seas become 1 to 3 feet across all area waters on Friday.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers and thunderstorms.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: No advisory for seas. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.*

WINDS: East-southeast at 10 knots, with occasional higher gusts through the forecast period.

LOCAL SEAS: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters tonight; seas become 1 to 3 feet across all area waters on Friday.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers and thunderstorms.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: --No advisory--

WINDS: East-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with occasional higher gusts.

LOCAL SEAS: 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers with the slight chance for a thunderstorm through the forecast period.



SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: --No advisory--
WINDS: East-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts through the forecast period.
LOCAL SEAS: 2 to 4 feet across all area waters through the forecast period.
SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
WEATHER: Isolated showers with the slight chance for a thunderstorm through the forecast period.
