



## BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT WEDNESDAY JULY 01, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

**WARNINGS:**

**Marine Heat Advisory:** Mariners are advised that **high heat indices** (above 105°F/40.5°C) are expected across the waters of The Bahamas. Prolonged exposure to the sun and hot conditions may increase the risk of heat-related illnesses. Stay hydrated, limit strenuous activity, seek shade when possible, and monitor crew members for signs of heat stress.

Northern Bahamas: Thunderstorms in the area can become strong-to-severe at times.

**GENERAL SITUATION:**

Weak riding will maintain mostly light to gentle breezes across the islands through Friday. A stationary front draped across the Northern Bahamas will support widely scattered showers and thunderstorms across the area through late Thursday. Elsewhere, daytime heating will be the primary trigger for convective activity. This weekend the chances of convection will decrease as a plume of Sahara dust spreads northwest across the islands.

### NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** No advisory for seas. *Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.*
- WINDS:** Westerly at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable at times through Thursday.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet across all area waters tonight; 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters on Thursday.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Chance for a few isolated showers and or a possible thunderstorm.

### NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** **--No Advisory--**
- WINDS:** Northeast to east at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable at times through Thursday.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet across all area waters tonight; 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters on Thursday.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Chance for a few isolated showers or a possible thunderstorm.

### CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

- ADVISORY:** **--No Advisory--**
- WINDS:** East at 10 knots, falling light and variable at times tonight; occasional higher gusts expected on Thursday.
- LOCAL SEAS:** 1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters through Thursday.
- SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.
- WEATHER:** Chance for a few isolated showers or a possible thunderstorm.

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):**

**ADVISORY:** No advisory for seas.  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, with occasional higher gusts through Thursday.  
**LOCAL SEAS:** 2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 3 to 5 feet on the Atlantic waters through Thursday.  
**SWELLS:** No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.  
**WEATHER:** Chance for a few isolated showers and thunderstorms.

1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters.

2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 3 to 5 feet on the Atlantic waters.

**ADVISORY:**

*There is a **small craft advisory** in effect for the Atlantic waters of the Southeast Bahamas.*

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:  
Southeast to south at 10 knots, with occasional higher gusts.

**WINDS:**

Southeast Bahamas:  
Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts.

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:  
1 to 3 feet on the sheltered waters and 2 to 4 feet on the Atlantic waters.

**SEAS:**

Southeast Bahamas:  
2 to 4 feet on the sheltered waters and 4 to 6 feet on the Atlantic waters.

**PRECIPITATION:**

All areas:  
Isolated showers and thunderstorms, mainly during the afternoon hours.
