



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT FRIDAY, AUGUST 01, 2025, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

There is a high risk of rip currents for the eastern coastal waters of the Southeast

Bahamas, including the coastal waters exposed to the lower extent of the Great Bahama

Bank.

WARNINGS:
There is a slight risk of rip currents for the east to southeast coastal waters elsewhere around

the island chain.

A relatively weak ridge of high pressure will steer gentle to moderate winds across most of the islands through early next week; the southeast Bahamas will experience moderate to fresh easterly winds through Saturday before the winds decrease on Saturday night. The typical summertime pattern is expected to generate periods of isolated convection

across the island chain during peak heating hours of the day.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: No advisory.

GENERAL SITUATION:

WINDS: South-southeast at around 10 knots tonight through Saturday, falling light and variable at

times.

LOCAL SEAS: Less than 3 feet across area waters.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers with the chance for a thunderstorm.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: No advisory.

WINDS: East-southeast at around 10 knots through Saturday, falling light and variable at times.

LOCAL SEAS: Less than 3 feet across area waters.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers with the chance for a thunderstorm.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

$(INCLUDING\ EXUMA,\ CAT\ ISLAND,\ LONG\ ISLAND,\ SAN\ SALVADOR,\ RUM\ CAY\ \&\ ADJACENT\ WATERS):$

ADVISORY: No advisory.

WINDS: East at 10 to 15 knots with higher wind gusts on the Great Bahama Bank.

LOCAL SEAS: 1 to 3 feet across all area waters with peaks to 5 feet on the Great Bahama Bank.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers with the chance for a thunderstorm.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

$(INCLUDING\ INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED\ ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED\ ISLAND\ \&\ ADJACENT\ WATERS):$

ADVISORY: There is a small craft caution in effect through Saturday.

WINDS: East at 15 to 20 with occasional higher gusts through Saturday.

LOCAL SEAS: 4 to 6 feet across all area waters through Saturday with occasional peaks to 7 feet.

SWELLS: No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER: Isolated showers with the slight chance for a thunderstorm.

All areas:

ADVISORY: Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of

showers and thunderstorms.

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:

East-southeast to south-southeast at around 10 knots falling light and variable at times; higher gusts expected on the Great Bahama Bank in both the Northwest and Central

Bahamas.

Southeast Bahamas:

East at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts.

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:

1 to 3 feet across all area waters with peaks to 5 feet on the Great Bahama Bank.

SEAS: Southeast Bahamas:

2 to 4 feet across all area waters.

All areas:

PRECIPITATION: Isolated showers with the chance for a thunderstorm or two.

East at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts.

Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:

1 to 3 feet across all area waters.

SEAS:

Southeast Bahamas:

2 to 4 feet across all area waters.
