



## BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT THURSDAY, AUGUST 28 , 2025, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNINGS:

There is a slight risk of rip currents across all area waters of the island chain.  
*Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Thunderstorms can become strong-to-severe at times with the possibility of waterspout activity.*

GENERAL SITUATION:

Generally light to gentle breezes are expected due to weak ridging across the islands. Upper-level troughing and a stationary frontal boundary will help to enhance periods of convection across the islands into the weekend, especially across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. A low-pressure center is expected to form along the boundary by the latter half of the weekend, helping to maintain the chances for rainfall across the islands.

### NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

No advisory for seas. Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.

WINDS:

Southeast to south tonight, becoming east to southeast on Friday at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.

LOCAL SEAS:

1 to 3 feet across area waters.

SWELLS:

No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER:

Chance for a brief passing shower tonight. Widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms possible on Friday.

### NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

No advisory for seas. Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.

WINDS:

East to southeast at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.

LOCAL SEAS:

1 to 3 feet across all area waters.

SWELLS:

No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER:

Chance for a brief passing shower tonight. Widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms possible on Friday.

### CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

No advisory for seas.

WINDS:

East-southeast to south-southeast at around 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.

LOCAL SEAS:

1 to 3 feet across all area waters.

SWELLS:

No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER:

Chance for a brief passing shower tonight.

### SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

No advisory for seas.

WINDS:

East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts on Friday.

LOCAL SEAS:

2 to 4 feet across all area waters.

SWELLS:

No significant swells on the Atlantic waters.

WEATHER:

Chance for a brief passing shower tonight. Chance for a few isolated showers on Friday with the slight chance for a thunderstorm.

Elsewhere, tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next 7 days...

South to southwest in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas and east to southeast at in the Central and Southeast Bahamas at around 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.

SEAS:

All areas:  
1 to 3 feet across all area waters.

PRECIPITATION:

Northern and Northwest Bahamas:  
Widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.

Central and Southeast Bahamas:  
Isolated showers and Thunderstorms.

Widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.

**PRECIPITATION:**

Central and Southeast Bahamas:

Isolated showers and Thunderstorms.
