MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9^{TH} , 2025, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

Rip Currents: There is a moderate risk of rip currents mainly along Atlantic

exposed shorelines. Therefore, beachgoers and swimmers are advised to remain

vigilant

The stationary front across the Northwest Bahamas continues to generate cloudy

conditions and showers over the area. Meanwhile, weak ridging over the Southeast

GENERAL SITUATION: Bahamas will continue to limit shower activity across those islands. Cloudiness and

shower activity is expected to persist across the Northwest and Central Bahamas

due to the stationary frontal boundary until the weekend.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

Small craft advisory is in effect for the Gulfstream and Atlantic exposed waters

through tomorrow.

WINDS: Northeasterly at 20 knots tonight, becoming 10 to 15 knots tomorrow.

LOCAL SEAS: 3 feet or less in sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet in open water and 5 to 8 feet in Atlantic waters

through tomorrow.

GULF STREAM: 5 to 7 feet tonight, becoming 3 to 5 feet tomorrow.

SWELLS: Large Northeasterly swells.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory is in effect for the Atlantic exposed waters through tomorrow.

WINDS: North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight becoming light and variable tomorrow.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet in open water and 5 to 8 feet in Atlantic waters

through tomorrow.

SWELLS: Large northerly swells.

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy with widely scattered showers through tomorrow.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic exposed waters tomorrow.

WINDS: South to southwest at 10 knots or less tonight through tomorrow.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet in open water and 5 to 8 feet in Atlantic waters

through tomorrow.

SWELLS: Light easterly swells tonight, becoming moderate to large northerly swells tomorrow.

WEATHER: Partly to mostly cloudy with widely scattered showers through tomorrow.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY: Small craft caution is in effect for Atlantic exposed waters tomorrow.

WINDS: Southeasterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times through tomorrow.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR Thursday, 11th December, 2025:

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory is in effect for the Atlantic exposed waters

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Northwesterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

WINDS: Central Bahamas: West to northwest at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Southeast Bahamas: Light and variable.

SEAS: All areas: 3 feet or less in sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet in open water and 5 to 7 feet in

Atlantic waters and Gulf stream.

Northwest and Central Bahamas: Mostly cloudy with widely scattered showers.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a slight chance of

scattered showers.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR Friday, 12th December, 2025:

ADVISORY: Small craft advisory is in effect for the Atlantic exposed waters

Northern Northwest and Central Bahamas: North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots with

WINDS: higher gusts.

Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots.

All areas: 3 feet or less in sheltered waters, 2 to 4 feet in open waters and Gulf stream,

SEAS: and 5 to 7 feet in Atlantic waters.

Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny with a slight chance of isolated

PRECIPITATION: showers.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Mostly cloudy with scattered showers.
