GENERAL SITUATION: An upper level low along with the northern extent of a westward-moving wave will continue to support pockets of unsettled weather over portion Bahamas through tomorrow. Moderate to locally strong breezes will a over the islands through tomorrow.			
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Residents can expect localized flooding in low-lying and flood-prone areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events. There is the potential of waterspout activity associated with thunderstorm clouds. The risk of hazardous rip currents remains, especially along eastern and southern shorelines of the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas.
