


### BAHAMAS TEMPERATURE & RAINFALL OUTLOOK




#### Rainfall Patterns August to October 2025




August marks the wet season, though it often features a brief mid-summer dry spell. The wet season continues from September to October, typically bringing frequent and heavy showers.


## Rainfall Outlook August to October 2025




Rainfall totals in The Bahamas from August to October are expected to be near or below average.

## Temperature Outlook August to October 2025







Night-time and daytime temperatures from August to October are forecast to be at least as high as usual, with medium to high confidence. However, the peak intensity of the 2025 Heat Season is not expected to reach the levels observed in 2023 and 2024.

# Climate Outlook November 2025 to January 2026

The period marks the transition out of Caribbean Wet Season, the Atlantic Hurricane Season, and the Heat Season and into the cooler, early Dry Season in December and January. The tropical North Atlantic Ocean is forecast to remain slightly warmer than average in and around the north of the Caribbean region. Unusually, high air temperatures will most likely prevail with significant heat stress to ease in October and mild temperatures returning in December. The risk of severe weather impacts, including flooding, flash floods, and cascading impacts is expected to be higher than usual, while rainfall totals might be even higher than usual. Hurricane season activity may be unusually high, particularly in areas north and west of the unusually warm waters.
