




# BAHAMAS TEMPERATURE & RAINFALL OUTLOOK





## Rainfall Patterns January to March 2026




Between January and March, weather conditions are generally sunny, with occasional periods of rainfall.

## Rainfall Outlook January to March 2026



Currently, rainfall totals across The Bahamas from January to March are not expected to be widespread record lows or highs.

## Temperature Outlook January to March 2026



In the Bahamas, forecast conditions do not indicate a significant risk of widespread hazardous heat stress events during this period.

## Climate Outlook April to June 2026

This period represents the transition into the 2025 Heat Season in April or May, followed by the onset of the Wet Season in May or June and the Atlantic Hurricane Season in June. Forecast conditions indicate an unseasonably warm Tropical and Subtropical North Atlantic, along with ENSO-neutral conditions. Temperatures are expected to become increasingly uncomfortable by April and May, with higher heat and humidity likely to persist into the 2026 Heat Season. The risk of severe weather impacts from intense rainfall, including flooding, flash flooding, and cascading effects, is projected to be moderate to high by May. Meanwhile, dry-season conditions may continue in some areas and could be intensified by increased evapotranspiration associated with unusual heat, particularly in regions where drought conditions are developing.
