
BAHAMAS TEMPERATURE & RAINFALL OUTLOOK


November 2024 to January 2025 Drought Outlook






The Bahamas is transitioning to the dry season and decreasing shower frequency and intensity. January would have sunny days and some days of showers. There is no concern about drought in the Bahamas through the end of December.


November 2024 to January, 2025 Rainfall Outlook



Rainfall amounts in The Bahamas for November-December-January period are expected to be usual or less.

November 2024 to December 2025 Temperature Outlook





The temperatures as well as air humidity will likely be considerably higher than usual in most areas. The episodes of heat stress are expected to steadily decrease through November now that the recording-breaking 2024 Heat Season is finally to an end. The heat stress should no longer be a significant hazard after November.

Climate Outlook February to April 2025

This period marks the peak of the 2024-2025 Caribbean Dry Season and the transition out of the Cool Season in March and into the 2025 Heat Season in April. An unseasonably warm Tropical North Atlantic and, possibly, weak La Niña conditions are forecast. More comfortable temperatures, though likely higher and with more humidity than usual are forecast for this Cool Season, with a likely accelerated transition into the 2025 Heat Season. An intense dry season peak is forecast for The Bahamas.

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
