NEWS ITEMS ON **TROPICAL STORM JERRY** ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, AT 12:00 PM SATURDAY 11TH, OCTOBER 2025.

...DISHEVELED JERRY MAY NOT LAST MUCH LONGER AS A TROPICAL STORM...

AT 11:00 EDT, THE CENTER OF **TROPICAL STORM JERRY** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 25.8° NORTH AND LONGITUDE 63.2° WEST** OR ABOUT 460 MILES SOUTH-SOUTHEAST OF BERMUDA.

JERRY IS MOVING TOWARD THE NORTH AT 16 MILES PER HOUR. THIS GENERAL MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE TODAY.

MAXIMUM **SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 50 MILES PER HOUR** WITH HIGHER GUSTS. WEAKENING IS FORECAST DURING THE NEXT FEW DAYS AND JERRY COULD DEGENERATE INTO A TROUGH OF LOW PRESSURE AT ANY TIME.
