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NEWS ITEM

THIS IS A NEWS ITEM ON **TROPICAL STORM DEXTER**, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY FORECAST OFFICE AT **6AM EDT, THURSDAY 7TH AUGUST, 2025**.

... DEXTER EXPECTED TO BECOME A STRONG EXTRATROPICAL LOW OVER THE NORTH ATLANTIC DURING THE NEXT SEVERAL HOURS...

AT 5:00 AM EDT, THE CENTER OF **TROPICAL STORM DEXTER** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 40.6° NORTH AND LONGITUDE 52.1° WEST** OR ABOUT **425 MILES SOUTH OF CAPE RACE NEWFOUNDLAND**.

DEXTER IS MOVING TOWARD THE EAST-NORTHEAST NEAR 18 MILES PER HOUR. AN EAST-NORTHEAST TO NORTHEAST MOTION IS EXPECTED DURING THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 50 MILES PER HOUR WITH HIGHER GUSTS. DEXTER IS EXPECTED TO STRENGTHEN AS AN EXTRATROPICAL LOW LATER TODAY THROUGH FRIDAY. THE CYCLONE IS FORECAST TO WEAKEN BEGINNING FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY.
