NEWS ITEM ON **TROPICAL DEPRESSION FAY**, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY, FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, ON SATURDAY 26TH, SEPTEMBER 2026 AT 6:00 PM EDT.

... ..FAY SLOWLY MOVING SOUTHWARD.....

AT 5:00 PM EDT, THE CENTER OF **TROPICAL DEPRESSION FAY** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 29.8° NORTH AND LONGITUDE 43.9° WEST**, OR ABOUT **1120 MILES WEST-SOUTHWEST** OF THE AZORES.

THE DEPRESSION IS MOVING TOWARD THE **SOUTH** NEAR **2 MPH**. THIS MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE FOR THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS WITH A GRADUAL INCREASE IN FORWARD SPEED.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR **35 MPH** (55 KM/H) WITH HIGHER GUSTS. LITTLE CHANCE IN STRENGTH IS FORECAST OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS.

THIS SYSTEM POSES NO THREAT TO THE BAHAMAS.

NEWS ITEM ON **POST-TROPICAL STORM GONZALO**, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY, FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, ON SATURDAY 26TH, SEPTEMBER 2026 AT 6:00 PM EDT.

***...GONZALO NO LONGER A TROPICAL CYCLONE...
...THIS IS THE FINAL NEWS ITEM...***

AT 5:00 PM EDT, THE CENTER OF **POST-TROPICAL STORM GONZALO** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 19.3° NORTH AND LONGITUDE 23.3° WEST**, OR ABOUT **180 MILES NORTH** OF SAL CABO VERDE.

GONZALO IS MOVING TOWARD THE **NORTH-NORTHWEST** NEAR **7 MPH**. THIS MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH THE WEEKEND, WITH A DECELERATION AND A TURN TO THE WEST-NORTHWEST EXPECTED EARLY NEXT WEEK.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS REMAIN NEAR 40 MPH (65 KM/H) WITH HIGHER GUSTS. ADDITIONAL WEAKENING IS ANTICIPATED, AND GONZALO IS EXPECTED TO DISSIPATE OVER THE EASTERN SUBTROPICAL ATLANTIC BY EARLY TO MID NEXT WEEK.

THIS SYSTEM CURRENTLY POSES NO THREAT TO THE BAHAMAS.
