SEVERE WEATHER WARNING RE-ISSUED

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has re-issued A Severe Thunderstorm Warning from 4:10 PM TO 6:30 pm TUESDAY 7TH APRIL 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning remains in effect for Abaco and now includes New Providence, Northern and Central Eleuthera, their surrounding cays along with their adjacent waters.

At 4:00 pm lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted a line of showers and embedded thunderstorms moving east and southeast across the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with a low level disturbance combined with a frontal boundary across Central Florida.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning areas should seek safe harbor and residents should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.
