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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued A Severe Thunderstorm Warning from 9:20 pm until 11:00 pm, Saturday 11th, October 2025.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning remains in effect for Long Island, San Salvador, Rum Cay and now includes Acklins and Crooked Island along with their adjacent waters.

A Severe Thunderstorm watch remains in effect for the islands of the Northwest and Central Bahamas

At 9:05 pm lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted a line of showers and embedded thunderstorms moving northeast and eastward toward and across the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with a pre-frontal activity ahead of a cold front across the Northern Bahamas.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail and or waterspout or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning area should seek safe harbor and residents in the warning areas should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.

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
