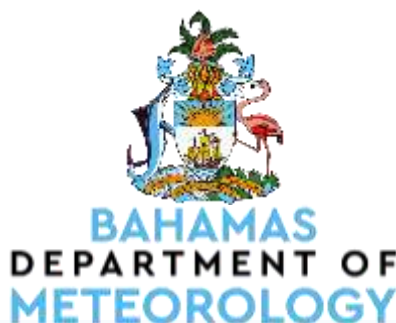

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING



THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2026 ON 9:30 PM EDT UNTIL 12:30 AM EDT, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2026.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS IN EFFECT FOR INAGUA, MAYAGUANA AND THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS, ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS.

A SEVERE WEATHER WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS AND THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS.

AT 9:10 PM EDT, OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY SHOWED INTENSIFYING CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD TOWARDS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH AN UPPER-LEVEL DISTURBANCE JUST SOUTH OF THE AREA.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
