SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE

THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS RE-ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING FROM 4:45 PM UNTIL 6:45 PM EDT, FRIDAY 5TH NOVEMBER 2021.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS IN EFFECT FOR GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, NORTH AND CENTRAL ELEUTHERA, AND THE EXUMA CAYS, ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS.

A SEVERE WEATHER WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR THE BERRY ISLANDS, ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS.

AT 4:40 PM LIGHTNING DETECTOR, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY CONTINUED TO DEPICT CLUSTERS OF SHOWERS WITH EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS ASSOCIATED WITH A LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM IN THE EASTERN GULF OF MEXICO ALONG WITH STRONG FRONTAL SYSTEM IN THE VICINITY OF CENTRAL FLORIDA. THESE STORMS ARE MOVING NORTHEASTWARDS, TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY. LOCALIZED FLOODING IS ALSO POSSIBLE DURING THESE STORMS.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AND WATCH AREAS SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
