

**PUBLIC FORECAST FOR EXTREME NORTHWEST BAHAMAS FOR TONIGHT & TOMORROW FROM 6 PM  
TUESDAY 20<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2021**

**GENERAL SITUATION:** LIGHT TO MODERATE SOUTHEAST OR SOUTH WINDS AROUND THE WESTERN PERIPHERY OF THE BERMUDA HIGH WILL BE WITH US THROUGH MID WEEK. BELOW NORMAL TROPICAL MOISTURE CAN BE EXPECTED OVER OUR AREA DURING THIS TIME FRAME.

**SPECIAL WARNINGS:** THERE IS A RISK FOR A WATERSPOUT AND/OR STRONG THUNDERSTORM IN OUR AREA RESIDENTS SHOULD STILL LIMIT OUTDOOR ACTIVITY AND REMAIN HYDRATED DUE TO HIGH HEAT INDICES
