### SEVEN - DAY WEATHER FORECAST 28<sup>th</sup> JUNE- 4<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2021

A seasonably moist and unstable environment will hover over the islands as deep troughing associated with a low pressure system northeast of the area play a major role in producing unsettled conditions across the Bahamas. Winds will generally swing from the southeast with the strongest winds remaining across the Southeast Bahamas. High temperatures will range in the high 80's to low 90's with heat indices reaching into the triple digits, thus individuals are advised to remain hydrated.

**MONDAY 28<sup>TH</sup>** – Mix of sun and clouds, hot and humid with widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. Breezy in the Central and Southeast Bahamas. *Small craft operators should exercise caution in the Central and Southeast Bahamas.* **Winds:** East to Southeast at 10 to 15 knots in the Northwest Bahamas and Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots in the Central and Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 2 to 4 feet over the ocean in the Northwest Bahamas and 4 to 7 feet over the ocean, in the Central and Southeast Bahamas.

**TUESDAY 29<sup>TH</sup>** – Variably cloudy and hot with isolated showers and thunderstorms. Breezy conditions will persist across the Northwest and Central Bahamas and Windy conditions will prevail across the Southeast Bahamas. *Small craft operators should exercise caution in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and Small craft advisory is in effect for the Southeast Bahamas.* **Winds:** Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and East to Southeast at 20 to 25 knots in the Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 4 to 7 feet over the ocean in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and 7 to 10 feet over the ocean in the Southeast Bahamas.

**WEDNESDAY 30<sup>TH</sup>** – Variably cloudy, warm and breezy with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. *Small craft operators should exercise caution in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and a small craft Advisory is in effect for the Southeast Bahamas...Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.* **Winds:** Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with occasional gusts in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and Easterly at 15 to 25 knots in the Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 4 to 6 feet over the ocean in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and 5 to 8 feet over the ocean in the Southeast Bahamas.

**THURSDAY 1<sup>ST</sup>** – Variably cloudy and hot with isolated showers and thunderstorms in the Northwest and Central Bahamas and Cloudy to Overcast and breezy with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms in the Southeast Bahamas. *Small craft operators should exercise caution in the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.* **Winds:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots in the Northwest Bahamas and Easterly at 15 to 20 knots in the Central and Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 2 to 4 feet in the Northwest Bahamas and 4 to 6 feet over the ocean in the Central and Southeast Bahamas.

**FRIDAY 2<sup>ND</sup>** – Cloudy, hot and breezy with scattered showers and thunderstorms. Windy conditions across the Southeast Bahamas. *Small craft operators should exercise caution in the Central Bahamas and a small craft advisory is in effect for the Southeast Bahamas. Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.* **Winds:** Southeasterly at 15 knots in the Northwest Bahamas and 15 to 20 knots in the Central Bahamas. Easterly at 20 to 25 knots in the Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 3 to 5 feet in the Northwest Bahamas, 4 to 6 feet in the Central Bahamas and 7 to 10 feet over the ocean in the Southeast Bahamas.

**SATURDAY 3<sup>RD</sup>** – Cloudy, hot and breezy with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. **Winds:** Southeast to South at 10 to 15 knots in the Extreme Northwest Bahamas and southeast to south at 15 to 25 knots in the Remainder of the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas. *Small craft advisory is in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Expect gusty winds and higher seas in or near heavy showers and thunderstorms.* **Seas:** 2 TO 4 feet over the ocean in the Extreme Northwest Bahamas and 5 to 8 feet over the ocean in the Remainder of the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas.

**SUNDAY 4<sup>TH</sup>** – Partly cloudy and warm with isolated showers and thunderstorms. **Winds:** Southeast to South at 10 to 15 knots in the Extreme Northwest Bahamas; East to Southeast at 15 to 20 knots in the Remainder of the Northwest along with the Central and Southeast Bahamas. **Seas:** 2 to 4 feet over the ocean in the Extreme Northwest Bahamas and 4 to 6 feet in the Remainder of the Northwest along with the Central and Southeast Bahamas.
